North Dorset Village Marathon and Relay

Sunday 4th May 2025, 8:30 AM

A picturesque race along country lanes through the villages of Hinton St Mary, Marnhull, Stalbridge, Togber, Stour Row, Margaret Marsh, West Orchard, Farrington and Child Okeford.

Start: Sturminster Newton High School, Bath Road, Sturminster Newton, Dorset, DT10 1DT.

Course: The race follows the marathon course and is subdivided into 4 sections. Each team will be comprised of a maximum of 4 runners and a minimum of 2 runners.

Numbers: Numbers will **NOT** be posted. The team coordinator should present themselves at race headquarters from 7:00AM and declare the team/pick up the relay baton.

Closing Date: 26th April 2025 or when the limit of 40 teams is reached. No entries on the day.

Race Entry Requirements: Entrants to the relay must be 15 years of age or over on the day of the event if running one leg (17 if running two legs and 18 if running three legs). Dogs, wheelchairs, personal music players and baby buggies are not allowed. Infringement will lead to team disqualification.

Awards: Memento to all finishers, prizes to 1st, 2nd, 3rd all Male, all Female and Mixed teams.

Payment: Cheques should be made payable to 'Dorset Doddlers'.
